Winter Is Coming....

Snow Route

Parking during snowfall; Snow Routes: No person shall park any motor vehicle of any class on any street in the village after **2 inches (2")** of snow has fallen, until such time as the snow has been plowed to the side of the street in the following locations which are designated snow routes in the village:

Birch St. between Lincoln Highway and George Cies Way

Cedar St. between Lincoln Highway and George Cies Way

Lincoln Highway between east village limits and west village limits.

Any street in the village with curbing on both sides.

Any vehicle found illegally parked in the above-mentioned area may be towed away under the order of either the Police Department or the Public Works Department, and in addition to the fine, the violator or owner of the vehicle shall pay all necessary towing and storage charges.

Snow and Ice Removal from Sidewalks

The Village would like to remind all residents that there is an ordinance that requires all public sidewalks have snow and ice removed within 24 hours of accumulation. If there is a sidewalk that is abutting to your property, in front or to the side, you are responsible to keep these sidewalks clear.

Annual Garbage and Recycling Rate Increase

Please note the enclosed utility bill includes a quarterly increase of \$2.28 for trash fees. This increase reflects our contractual yearly increase with Lakeshore Recycling.

REMINDER: Please make sure water meters are accessible for public works to read and payments are due by midnight on the due date!

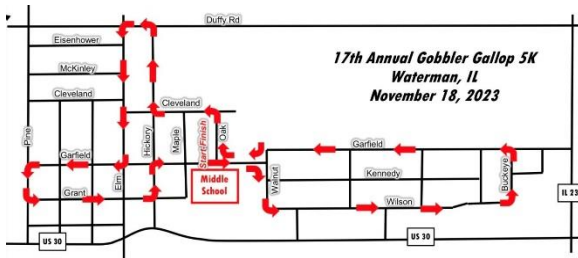
